Plaquanil is a medication used to treat various inflammatory conditions. This medication does not work quickly but rather takes weeks or even months to appreciate its full benefit.

How to take: Take as directed with food to minimize GI side effects.

Adverse Reactions: Any medication can cause problems. If you experience unusual symptoms including the following – please call the doctor: *Vision change (difficulty reading, blurring, sensitivity to light) *Headache, Dizziness *Nausea, abdominal pain *Chronic diarrhea *Loss of appetite, weight loss *Skin rash or allergic reaction *Ringing in the ears *Mood or mental changes

*Irregular heart beat

Monitoring:

*You must get regular eye exams if we keep you on this medication for greater than 6 months *You will have to check lab-work occasionally.
